



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I use my 4-H or previously assigned permanent number? Yes, any number is okay as long as you remove that number from the group of numbers being used that day.

Can registrations be left open? Yes, but a signed check to Wranglers must be left at the time of registration and we ask that you check out at the show office before you leave.

Do I need to pay an office fee for a Leadline-only entry? No, the office fee is waived.

At an open show, can I show in both walk/trot *and* classes with a canter/lope? Yes.

What is the dress code? Standard show attire for open shows is appreciated to show respect for our judge and fellow competitors. Nothing fancy or expensive is required, but safety should be considered. Boots are required and hats/helmets are recommended.

How do I add or scratch classes? Please tell the announcer's stand as soon as possible. Refunds are allowed but are only paid *at the end of your show day*.

Are there any breaks? At most open shows, we allow a few minutes to tack up after the last in-hand class and a 15-20 minute lunch break with open arena time after Leadline.

If I am awarded 1st place, do I get a trophy? If a trophy is meaningful to you, we encourage you to pick one out in the show office. To control costs, we only have a limited supply and encourage everyone to donate back trophies that say Salt Creek Wranglers.

How do I collect my ribbons? If we don't have a volunteer to hand out ribbons at the conclusion of each class, please visit the show office and take your ribbon any time.

How do I collect my payback? If you placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd at an open show, please visit the show office *at the end of your show day* and your total earnings will be paid in cash.

May I ask the judge questions about my performance? In most cases, it is only appropriate to approach a judge after you are done showing for the day and, of course, only during a break. At 4-H shows, judges are asked to make comments about their observations and placings, but this is up to the judge's discretion at open shows.

How can I volunteer at the show? Please tell the announcer's stand and they will happily put you to work! We need office, gate, and ribbon help at every show.

Can I host my own show at Wranglers? Yes, ask a board member for details. We would also love to bring back a speed series, but need the volunteers to make it work!
